The curriculum is that of a **U.S. college-preparatory school**. Instruction is in English and Spanish. A dual program prepares students for the *U.S. High School Diploma* and the *Colombian Bachillerato* degree. TCS offers 18 AP courses and is accredited by **COGNIA** and the *Colombian Ministry of Education*. The graduation rate is 100%, and students attend colleges and universities in the United States, Colombia, and Europe.
